# Perogy Fundraiser

**NEXT PEROGY ORDER DUE DATE: Thursday, February 19, 2009**

There are also **NO PLUM PEROGIES** available until further notice.

This is an ongoing credit system fundraiser. Orders are placed on a monthly basis. You can buy perogies for yourself and take orders for other individuals. This makes you a seller.

If your dancer is in Intermediate, T1, T2, or the Ensemble, your dancer will earn credits that can be used for future trips. Order forms are available in the lobby. Please take note of the directions below to make sure that your order is placed correctly and on time.

Complete a white Buyer's Order Form for every person that you sell to, then total up all of your Buyer's Order Forms onto a pink Seller's Order Form and submit the **pink** Seller's Order Form. *Make sure you check you addition and calculations before submitting your order. Do not submit the Buyer's Order Form.* You keep your Buyer's Order Forms for sorting your own order. If you are buying for yourself only, please submit your order on a **pink** Seller's Order Form anyway. *Payment must accompany your order - no exceptions, ie: no orders by fax, phone, or email. PLEASE, your co-operation in this area will make the co-ordinator's job easier.*

Please complete all the information as to your child's class level so that proper credits can be ensured. *If the proper information is not provided there is no guarantee that your child will receive a credit even if they are entitled to one.*

**New Order Drop-off Location!** Completed order forms and payment should be placed in a sealed envelope and labeled "**Perogy Order - Attention: Lori**" and are to be placed in the **white mailbox to the right of the door just inside the studio door.**

Perogy orders will be due on the following dates:

Thursday, March 19, 2009

Thursday, April 16, 2009

Thursday, May 14, 2009

Thursday, June 11, 2009

(No orders during July and August)

These dates are also posted in the studio lobby.

*Note: Any orders not received by the due date will be processed on the next due date. Any "add-ons" to an existing order must be submitted on a separate order form with the required payment and must be received by the due date to be included in the same order.*

Delivery of the perogies is approximately 10 days after the due date, depending on the volume of the order. After the perogies are sorted a notice will be posted in the studio lobby indicating that the perogies are ready for pickup and a telephone call or an e-mail might be sent. The bags will be marked with the seller's name and the number of total bags in your order.

**New Pick-up Procedure!** The freezers are located in a **locked** storage room. Someone with a key will be in the office every Wednesday evening or you can ask your child's instructor to unlock the door, as all of the instructors have a key to the storage room.
