Reminder - 2009-2010 Registration

Please send in your registration forms or send an email to the studio of you intend to bring it with you on the first night of dancing!

The 2009-2010 registration forms, together with the Tavia Handbook have been emailed out this past week to all of last year's dancers. If you haven't received yours, please e-mail the studio.

Class fee and bingo/Rider credit cheque amounts have both changed. Please make sure to read through your registration forms carefully and complete each section.

Take a moment to consider checking off your volunteer interests on the registration form. Several areas of volunteerism is available. Every area is important for the smooth operation and success of the organization.

Parent reps and Costume reps are required for each class. Parent reps may assist the instructors with communication with the class, at concerts, and performances. Costumes reps will be the liaison between the class and the Costume Committee and will be responsible to assist the Costume Committee in handing out and taking in rented costumes for their class. They may also be called upon to assist with sewing or mending.

Post-dated cheques for fees and bingo/Rider credit cheques must be sent in with your registration forms. Also, provide a post-dated cheque for Mosaic passes, as parents do not get in free unless they are volunteering.

Please also take a moment to read through the Tavia Handbook and pay particular attention to the In Class Behaviour and Discipline Policy which has been revamped. Your acknowledgement that you've read and discussed this with your child is required on the registration form.

If you have fulfilled your requirements for Bingos and / or Roughrider Games, for the current dance year, you may do additional Bingos and / or Roughrider Games and receive a \$50.00 credit to the dancer's fundraising account. This fundraising credit applies to Intermediates and up. For Sadochuk to Junior classes, extra bingos/Rider games worked above the credit requirement will be banked to fulfill future credit requirements. Note that if the number of volunteers for a particular bingo/Rider game exceeds the minimum number of volunteers required those people who have not fulfilled their bingo/Rider game requirements will be given priority to work.

This practice is not retroactive for those who have already exceeded their bingo/Rider game requirements. Any current credits will retained and applied to fulfill future requirements. Furthermore, you may continue to bank bingo/rider credits instead of taking a fundraising credit.
